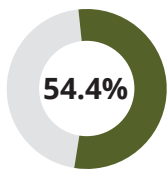

Our 349 students at a glance:

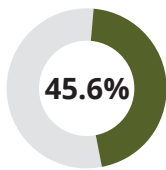


State Assessments

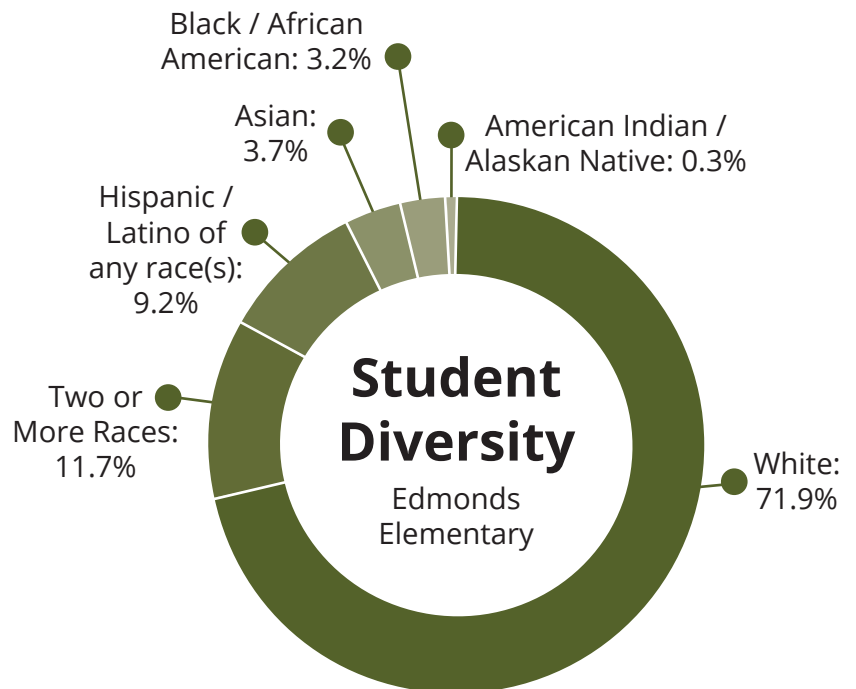

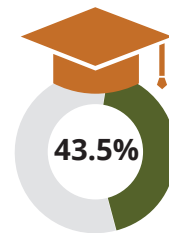
How You Can Help
