




### State Assessments


### Academic Accomplishments and Goals – Focus Areas

In 2020-21 Lynnwood Elementary is continuing to focus on our “ABC’s” – Academics, Behavior, and Culture.

Academically, we are continuing to dive into Culturally Responsive Teaching practices and working to shore up our student’s reading skills. With an emphasis on building a guaranteed and viable curriculum, implementing newly adopted reading curriculum, and creating a robust system which supports intervention, we aim to increase reading proficiency and build lifelong passion for reading.

Behaviorally, our focus this year is to hone into our Second Step curriculum, build our system wide practices, and equip teachers with the tools necessary to meet kids where they are at. We

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recognize too the importance of relationship and connection, focusing on social emotional learning amidst the pandemic.

Culturally, we are working to build a positive climate for students, families, and staff. Our efforts include working with a climate consultant, discussing and action planning around obstacles and barriers particularly around race and equity, and helping to build inclusionary practices.


