

Procedure - Community Service

Students may earn up to two (2) elective credits toward graduation based on the completion of community service hours outside of school. Ninety (90) hours of documented community service activity will be equal to .5 credit. Students who wish to earn elective credit must complete the following steps each school year for which they are seeking to earn elective credit:

1. Complete an "Application for Outside Credit" form prior to the start of any community service activity;
2. The application must be approved by the parent/guardian, counselor, and principal;
3. Track and document all hours spent in the community service activity;
4. Obtain the signature of the supervisor for the community service activity verifying that the hours documented are accurate;
5. Submit completed hours and the signature of supervisor to the home school registrar.

In addition, schools may implement processes to recognize student achievement in community service.
