

Response to Student Injury or Illness

The Edmonds School District Board of Directors recognizes that schools are responsible for providing first aid or emergency treatment in case of injury or illness of a student during school hours or at any school sponsored event. The district defines school sponsored events as events that are conducted on or off school premises, during or outside of the regular school day, under the supervision and guidance of a staff member or advisor.

The board encourages school staff to become certified in first aid. Further medical attention in non-emergency cases is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Schools will notify the parent or guardian of students who suffer injuries, illness or physical trauma at school or at any school-sponsored activity as soon as practicable.

The superintendent will establish procedures to be followed consistent with this policy.
