

Joint Use of Operating Facilities

It is the policy of Edmonds School District to allow the joint use of certain school spaces or venues during the school day when they are not required for school purposes. Outside use of all district facilities, not covered by a separate agreement, when school is not in session shall be governed by the Community Use of District Facilities Policy 4260 and Procedure 4260P.

Such joint use shall:

- A. Not interfere with the conduct of the district's programs and related activities,
- B. Be in the best interest of the district,
- C. Be for lawful purposes,
- D. Be for a reasonable time,
- E. Be compatible with the school education program and with the school community,
- F. Permit the district to recall use of the facility should it be needed for school purposes,
- G. Not be discriminatory.

Monies derived from Inter-Local Agreements, Memorandums of Understanding, or Joint Use Agreements shall be sufficient to pay district's expenses related to administration, maintenance, operations, insurance, or other cost attributed to user's use of district facilities.
