Edmonds (reflects 2019-20 allocations) Class Size Maximums before Eligibility for Additional Compensation

- K -- 19
- 1 -- 20
- 2-3 -- 21
- 4-6 -- 28.2
- K-3 -- 23
- 4 -- 27
- 5-6 -- 29

Mukilteo (2018-19)

- K -- 28 maximum; no class shall remain at 29 in excess of 15 school days
- 1-5 -- 30 maximum; no class shall remain at 31 in excess of 15 school days
- Combined -- maximum number is 27; no class shall remain at 28 in excess of 15 school days

Shoreline (2018-19)

- K-3 -- 21-22
- 4 -- 28-29
- 5-6 -- 29-30

Everett (goals) (2018-19)

- K -- 24 or fewer
- 1-3 -- 25 or fewer
- 4 -- 26 or fewer
- 5 -- 27 or fewer
- Combined classes -- 3 fewer students than the lower grade level goal

Lake Washington (2018-19)

- K-1 -- 24 students
- 2-3 -- 26 students
- 4-5 -- 28 students
- Split classes K-3 -- 25
- Split classes 3-4 -- 26
- Split classes 4-5 -- 27

Northshore (2018-19)

- K -- 24 to 1
- 1 -- 24 to 1
- 2-3 -- 26 to 1
- 4-6 -- 27 to 1

Bellevue (2018-19)

Average class size in elementary schools shall not exceed a district-wide average of 24 students.

- K -- 22
- 1-3 -- 24
- 4-5 -- 27

Renton (2018-19)

High Poverty Schools

- K-1 -- 21 to 1
- 2 -- 22 to 1
- 3 -- 24 to 1
- 4-5 -- 29 to 1

Non-Poverty Schools

- K-3 -- 24 to 1
- 4-5 -- 29 to 1

Highline (2018-19)

- K -- Building's average yearly K enrollment divided by 23.5
- 1-3 -- Building's average yearly 1-3 enrollment divided by 24
- 4-6 -- Building's 4-6 average yearly enrollment divided by 26.5

Federal Way (2018-19)

- K-3 -- 26
- 4-5 -- 29
- 3-4-5 or 3-4 -- 28

Issaquah (2018-19)

- K-2 -- 20 to 1, with a range of 17 to 23
- 3-5 -- 24 to 1, with a range of 21 to 27
- $\frac{2}{3}$ multiage or combination -- 23 to 1, with a range of 20 to 26

Staffing Ratios--Secondary

Edmonds (2019-20)

- 7-12 -- 27
- Total daily load 7-8 -- 154
- Total daily load 9-12 -- 155

Class Size Maximums for Trigger Purpose

- 7-8 -- 31 students with total daily load of 154
- 9-12 -- 31 students with total daily load of 155

Mukilteo (2018-19)

- 6-8 -- 30 maximum assigned to any class section; maximum of 31 for no more than 15 school days
- 9-12 -- 33 maximum assigned to any class section; maximum of 34 for no more than 15 school days
- 6-12 -- 165 maximum daily load; maximum of 166 for no more than 15 school days

Shoreline (2018-19)

- Total daily load at 149

Everett (2018-19)

- 6-8 -- 29, with daily load of 174 or fewer (6 x 29)
- 9-12 -- 30, with daily load of 150 (5 x 30)

Lake Washington (2018-19)

- 6-8 -- not to exceed 30; total daily load not to exceed 150 students
- 9-12 -- not to exceed 32; total daily load not to exceed 155 students

Northshore (2018-19)

- 31 to 1, with total daily load of 150:1

Bellevue (2018-19)

Average class size shall not exceed a district wide average of 28 students.

- 6-8 -- 29
- 9-12 -- 33

Renton (2018-19)

- 6-12 -- 29 to 1; daily total 145 for $\frac{1}{2}$ classes, 116 for $\frac{1}{4}$ classes

Highline (2018-19)

- 7-8 -- Building's average yearly enrollment divided by 28
- 9-12 -- Building's average yearly enrollment divided by 28.5

Federal Way (2018-19)

- 6-8 -- 31; core team classes will be considered overloaded when the total number of students exceeds 62 or 93 students
- 9-12 -- 32 with no more than 151 students daily

Issaquah(2018-19)

- 6-8 -- 29
- 9-12 -- 33
