## SUMMER FUN! LEARN TO SAIL AT KINGSTON COVE

### YOUTH SAILING PROGRAM, TEACHING BOATING KNOWLEDGE, SAFETY AND BASIC SKILLS

- ▶ ENROLL YOUR CHILDREN IN A COMPREHENSIVE CURRICULUM THAT PROVIDES THEM WITH A GOOD UNDERSTANDING OF THE BASICS OF SAILING IN WEEK LONG SAILING CAMPS FOR AGES 8-17.
- ▶ CLASSES SCHEDULED TO START ON JULY 5, 2016 AND CONTINUE THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2, 2016.\*
- ▶ OPTI 1 CLASSES - AGES 8-12- THIS COURSE TEACHES THE BASICS OF RIGGING, SAIL AND TILLER CONTROL, AND HOW TO HANDLE THE EQUIPMENT. BY THE END OF THE CLASS, MOST SAILORS WILL BE ABLE TO PUT TOGETHER AN OPTI AND HAVE SOME CONTROL OF THE BOAT IN A LIGHT BREEZE. NO EXPERIENCE IS NECESSARY FOR OPTI 1.
- ▶ OPTI 2 CLASSES - AGES 8-12 - THIS COURSE TEACHES MORE ADVANCED SAILING TECHNIQUES; SAILING UP WIND, BOAT HANDLING, STOPPING AND STARTING, TACKING, GYBING AND IS FOR SAILORS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THE OPTI 1 CLASS.
- ▶ TEEN BEGINNING SAILING - 13 - 17 - THIS COURSE IS FOR TEENS WHO WANT TO LEARN BASIC SAILING, MUCH LIKE THE OPTI 1 CLASS, BUT IN LARGER BOATS THAT CAN ACCOMMODATE THIS WEIGHT CLASS.
- ▶ \$200 OPTI 1 & 2 WEEKLY SESSION. \$225 TEEN BEGINNER WEEKLY SESSION.
