Free Summer Math and Lunch Program
Weekdays July 7—Aug 14

Math sessions: 9:00-11:30 and 11:30-2:00 Free Lunch from 11:00-12:00

Seeking volunteers to help on a regular, but not necessarily a daily basis, for the following positions:

Lead Math Instructors: Volunteers who are proficient in math through at least Algebra 1. They will work with students needing help with higher levels of math. They will provide help on lower level math topics for students who need additional support beyond that provided by the high school math tutors.

Math Coaches: Help students with the basics like flash cards, math facts, fractions, decimals and other arithmetic and pre-algebra concepts. You will be trained to coach students using one or more of the following programs: [Xtra Math](#), [Khan Academy](#), [Scratch](#) and Moby Max. Coaches monitor student performance in real time stepping in to help when asked or when the real-time data indicates that a student is struggling to grasp a concept.

Reading Coaches: Help students find the joy in reading that comes from improved fluency and comprehension. Volunteers will receive an orientation on the best strategies to use to support growth in reading skills. Students will be reading from books as well as the online program [Raz Kids](#). If you love to read, this is a great opportunity to use your passion to help others.

Free Lunch Program Supervisors: Volunteers at each site who will oversee the lunch program volunteers and ensure that the areas used for lunch are supervised, used as intended and that students clean up the area prior to leaving after lunch.

Lunchroom reading and math volunteers: Will interact with children who come for the free lunch to make sure that everyone gets along, behaves in an appropriate and safe manner and has a good time during lunch from 11:00 am—12:00 noon.

Be a Reading Buddy for students who want to work on their reading skills during lunch. Help younger students practice their basic math facts with flash cards or the online math fact program Xtra Math.
