

New Lynnwood High School



PROJECT TIMELINE

May 2004: Voters approve \$2,900,000 for preliminary design of the school.

July 2004: School Board re-approves Bassetti Architects for preliminary design planning.

October & November 2004: A 50-member Planning Advisory and Review Committee (P.A.R.C.) assembles to discuss District design goals and tours 3 new schools in the Federal Way School District.

December 2004: North Road site identified thru a District Property study as the best location for the new school.

May 2005: A Design Review Committee (DRC), consisting of district staff, parents, community members, district administrators and consultants, is formed to provide input for key design decisions.

July 2005: Board of Directors approve Educational Specifications. Bassetti Architects begins Schematic design phase.

September 2005: Schematic design is presented to Design Review Committee. The DRC to meet on a regular basis every two weeks during the design phase as needed.

January 2006: School Board approves the Schematic Design on January 24.

February 2006: Voters passed a \$140,000,000 construction Bond on February 7 to fund construction.

July 2006: School Board approves both the Value Engineering study and the 100% Design Development documents on July 11 allowing the Construction Documents phase to begin.

October 2006: School Board approves the timber harvest plan

November 2006: An Open House was held on November 15 at Martha Lake school. Construction and bidding documents reach 90% completion. Application for the general building permit submitted.

December 2006: Installation of temporary fencing around the site begins.

March 2007: Timber harvest begins. Bid documents for contractors publically advertised.

April 2007: Timber harvest ends; construction bids opened on April 24.

June 2007: Construction contract awarded for \$68,425,000; Groundbreaking ceremony.

August 2009: Furnishings, equipment installation. Revised Substantial Completion. Staff moved in.

September 2009: School Opened September 8 for students!

October 2009: Dedication Ceremony was held on October 3.
