The Edmonds School District is looking for community members and service providers to volunteer for our Community Truancy Boards for the 2019-2020 school year.



The purpose of a community truancy board (CTB) is to identify the root causes of truant behavior and provide resources or interventions to youth and families in a collaborative and supportive manner.

The truancy board makes recommendations to student, parents and the school with the goal of improving a students attendance record. Recommendations may include referral to counseling, medical screening, drug & alcohol testing, and checkings with school staff.

CTB's are a preferred intervention before referring to truancy court.

Your commitment:

- ❖ 1-2 hour training prior to participating in the first CTB meeting.
- ❖ Members participate in at least 1 CTB meeting during the school year.

Meetings: Meetings will take place at the district office or local schools. Dates and times will be provided to members at the training.
